There had been one application from Mr David Pite, who was co-opted following a unanimous vote. Mr Pite signed the Declaration of Acceptance of Office.

21/073 Chairman’s report
The Chairman reported that Poulsons had finished putting down Fittleworth Stone on the remaining area in the car park opposite the White Horse. They had done this free of charge in return for using the area for keeping their plant equipment whilst upgrading the bridleway behind School House.

The Chairman reported that the newly upgraded bridleway behind School House would have a specially constructed gate to provide access to horses but deter motorbikes.

21/074 Reports from Councillors
Cllr Deanus advised that data collected re HGV use of Markwick Lane and joining lanes had been disputed. Surrey Highways had agreed to conduct a wider survey to look at HGV use in the area. Hascombe and Hambledon Parish Councils would offer a meeting to neighbouring town and parish councils to discuss the scheme as it would be necessary for them to be in agreement before weight restrictions could be implemented.
